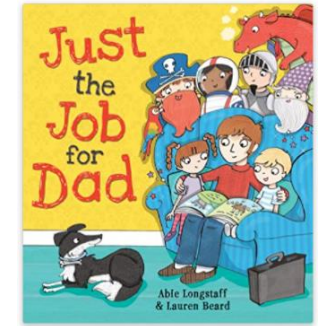
senses	any of five ways to understand our surroundings. These are touch, smell, taste, sight, and hearing.

Key Knowledge

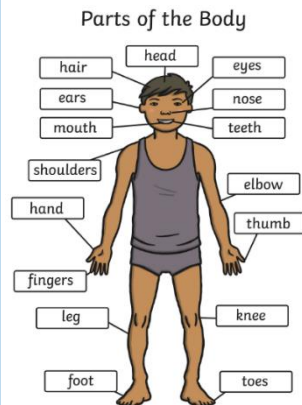
